Introduction

The Co-operative Party Rule Book was last updated in September 2016 at the Annual Conference.

Section A contains the Rules of Co-operative Party Ltd. These are the rules governing the Society and registered with the Financial Services Authority. Changes to these rules require the approval of the FCA. The remaining sections contain the rules relating to individual members and to local parties.

Any changes to these rules automatically update local rules. This means that if your local branch or party has rules that pre-date the model rules, the model rules will apply.
