Have you ever thought about becoming a Councillor? Would you like to explore the possibility of doing so as a Co-operative candidate? Want to find out more... here you go...

The South West Peninsula Co-operative Party Council has opened its application window for people wishing too be added to the list of approved members for selection as candidates in the 2018 Plymouth City Council elections.

To be eligible to stand you should have been a co-operative Party member for six months and be a member of a recognised Co-operative Society (such as the Co-operative Group, a Credit Union, Plymouth Energy Community or PEC Renewables).

Being on the Co-operative Party list means that if you are selected by the Labour Party you can stand as a Labour and Co-operative Party Candidate.
